



How to Collect Used Vegetable Oil

Thank you for your interest in recycling your cooking oil. It will be used to make biodiesel in our region!

Always **cool down** used oil before collecting.

Only collect **vegetable or plant based** oil (corn oil, olive oil, canola oil, sunflower oil, etc).

Grease and fats from meats are not collectable at this time. These products should be cooled until in a solid form and disposed of in the trash or made into suet to feed the birds in winter.

For very small amounts of oil, wipe up with a paper towel and dispose of towel in trash.

When pouring oil into container, it is ideal to strain out food scraps and dispose of scraps in compost bin or trash. Some small scraps or floaters in the oil are fine.

Make sure you pour oil into a clean, non-breakable (non-glass) container with a tight-fitting lid, such as the original plastic or metal container.

Prevent water from getting into the oil.

Drop off sealed containers of oil to Cherry Hill Public Works/ DPW, at 1 Perina Blvd, off of Markkress Rd, around the corner from the Post office. Mon-Fri 7am to 3:30pm, Sat 8-12; same hours as e-waste. 856-424-4422.
